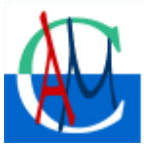

Fees (2010)

Individual:

\$C 2,000 plus 13% HST

Groups of 3 or more:

\$C 1,800 plus 13% HST each.

The group discount applies only up to the 4 week course cutoff date. After that individual fees and late registration terms apply.

Fees are due in advance to secure registration.

Class Size

The class is limited to 25 participants. Minimum class size is 16. If we do not have sufficient numbers registered by 4 weeks before class, then the class will have to be cancelled.

Cancellation

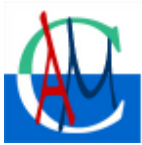
